THE SIR JAMES AND LADY PEIRIS CHESHIRE HOME - A HOME WITH OVER A HALF CENTURY OF SERVICE TO THOSE DIFFERENTLY ABLED

Cheshire Home for the Differently Abled was formally opened by late Group Captain Lord Leonard Cheshire, the Founder of the Leonard Cheshire Disability on the 19th March 1966.

The premises were provided to the “Leonard Cheshire Disability” to manage a Home for persons who were Differently Abled.

Organizational Structure of the Home

Over the past fifty years the Home has functioned with a Board of Management with a Chairman at its apex. The present Chairperson is a descendant of the late Sir James and Lady Peiris, Mrs. Mala Salgado.

The Board of Management is comprised of nearly twenty persons who all serve in an honorary capacity, contributing in several ways with their individual abilities and talent. They meet monthly to take collective decisions in the best interests of the welfare of the residents and the betterment of the Home.

Three sub committees see to the day to day operations of the Home, namely the Home Committee, Administrative Committee and Finance Committee.

The Residents

The Home presently caters to the needs of 14 residents, of whom 09 are in wheel chairs. We hope to take a few more residents in 2020/21.

Residents and their families are not charged a fee for all the services provided including physiotherapy, medicines, pampers, food etc.

As a part of Skill Development and Training, the residents produce envelopes, greetings cards, rugs, bags etc. Parts of the money obtained by selling these items, is given to the residents.

Their recreation and leisure are seen to by the Board of Management as well as concerned visitors. Various activities like film shows, sing along etc are organized to entertain the residents by various groups, whilst the Board of Management organizes the Aluth Avurudu and Christmas celebrations.

Special Project - Family Support Services

This scheme was inaugurated on the 70th Birthday of the late Group Captain Lord Cheshire in 1987 and reached out to families with handicapped members, to enable them to care for disabled people at home.

Three families were selected and a basket of necessities is being presented to them monthly. We hope to expand our services in this direction.

Conclusion

Though the Home is a recipient of an annual grant from the Social Services Department of the Western Province, Samurdhi Bank and the Dehiwela-Mount Lavinia Municipal Council, the sum received is wholly inadequate. Hence the continuing donations received from generous donors are critically important to the running of the Home.

SIR JAMES PEIRIS – REMEMBRANCE ON HIS 90TH DEATH ANNIVERSARY 5TH MAY 2020

“A Tribute by his great great grandson Ryan Rockwood”



Peiris was born on 20 December 1856 to Martinus Pieris and Apolonia de Soysa, one of the biggest landed proprietors in the country. During his teens, his father's honour led him to the financial rescue of a brother whose speculations came to grief. Thus, much of the family property was lost. The unhappy events were

compounded by the pre-mature death of his father and resultant comparative poverty. James was fond of recalling how these misfortunes were the making of him and his stoic ambitions to make good the position that he had lost. Peiris was educated at Colombo Academy (now Royal College, Colombo) where he excelled in studies winning the Turnour Prize for classics and the Shakespeare prize.

Peiris won the English University Scholarship in 1877 and proceeded to St John's College, at the University of Cambridge. At Cambridge he had the rare distinction of obtaining a double first – a first class in the Law Tripos and a first class in the Moral Science Tripos. There he was the first non-European to be elected President of the Cambridge Union in 1882. Returning to Ceylon in 1887 Peiris settled down to a successful law practice at the Ceylon Bar. His work took him to all parts of the country, and gave him an intimate knowledge of the needs and hardship of the people outside Colombo. Like a true son of Ceylon, he felt the desire to have his own plot of land and to develop it by his own efforts. Thus, he began planting coconut & cinnamon. He later purchased an estate in Haputale and set to work rooting out coffee and replacing it with what is now known world over as Ceylon tea. He worked for the abolition of the paddy tax which left thousands of poor rice farmers ruined during bad seasons and was subsequently elected first Chairman of the Low-Country Agricultural Products Association.

James married Grace, eldest daughter of Jacob de Mel of Horton Place, the pioneer graphite miner and merchant prince. The family was devoutly Christian and worshipped at St Michael's Church Polwatte. The youngest son became a famed musicologist, singer and teacher, devoting his time to study Sinhala folk music. Herbert changed his name to Devar Surya Sena and gifted his home in Colpetty, now the Surya Sena Centre for the furtherance of his passion.

Peiris' entry into politics was as a Member of the Colombo Municipal Council from 1898 to 1908 representing the Slave Island ward, and served on the Public Works Council. Though a reluctant politician at first, Peiris initiated constitutional reforms such as the abolition of the then system of racial representation and the introduction of the elective principle in place of nomination.

In 1920 Peiris was elected President of the Ceylon National Congress staunchly supported by D.S. Senanayake, F.R. Senanayake and Sir Ponnambalam Arunachalam. He continued the struggle for reforms and promoted greater representation of locals in the British government bureaucracy and the judiciary. After the 1921 elections, Peiris took his seat in the Legislative Council as member for Colombo. 1922 Peiris opposed the Supply Bill which sought to increase taxes on export & import duties, and higher rail fares to fund increased salaries and benefits for British Government officials. He led a walk out from the Legislative council over the matter and found himself the hero of the day.

In 1924 Peiris was elected as Vice-President – a position he held until his death in 1930. The majority of the voters of Ceylon accepted him very definitely as their leader at the time. The post of President was held nominally by the Governor and Peiris presided over the Council and acted as Officer Administering the Government. Peiris accepted in 1925 a knighthood from the King and was a Justice of the Peace for

the whole island. He was the first Ceylonese occupant of Queens House as Acting-Governor.

Peiris was also a champion of establishing a university for the country and secured funds for the establishment of the facility at Colombo. His grandson Professor Mark Cooray studied law at this university (plus, Cambridge) and has authored many books. Peiris was also a President of the Sinhalese Sports Club.

Among his manifold activities there was probably no cause that was dearer to James' heart than Social Service. He was a founder Chairman of the "Ceylon Social Service League." Today the "Sir James and Lady Peiris Cheshire Home" in Mt Lavinia stands on a property donated by Sir James Peiris. At present, for fourteen differently-abled male & female adults, this is their home. They are provided with all their needs free of charge.

Peiris is considered as one of the few distinguished Sri Lankan statesmen prior to its independence and is often referred to as the Father of Constitutional Reforms. Those vindicated due to his efforts became the subsequent leaders of the nation. When his portrait was unveiled in Parliament, the then Prime Minister, S. W. R. D. Bandaranaike stated: "Like Moses, James Peiris brought his people within sight of the promised land, but did not live to see its fulfilment."

REVIEW- 2020

The year under review, was dominated by the Corona Virus pandemic. We are thankful to the Department of Social Services who gave us a set of guidelines to follow during these difficult times. As instructed by them almost all our meals have been cooked in-house and donors have not been allowed inside the premises.

Residents missed the sing along sessions and other events organized by Donors. At Christmas time, the Board of Management organized a low-key Christmas party.

During the year we were sad to record the deaths of our Advisor Dr Ajith Perera and Resident Milroy (see the Memoriam section). No new residents were admitted. Of the residents, two are bedridden and require special care while seven use wheel chairs.

We continued to assist the three families, who each have a disabled child under the Family Support Scheme.

Renovations were begun this year. We look forward to seeing our donors at our new dining hall next year.

We take this opportunity to thank our staff, whose loyalty to the Home and commitment enables us to look after our residents lovingly.

In spite of the difficult time, a special thank you to ALL our donors who supported us. It is these contributions we receive that enables us to provide all the necessary facilities and comforts to the residents.

Milroy has Down Syndrome. He is now confined to his room. His family keep in close contact with him.

- **Mary Jane**

Mary is a very good-natured resident who interacts well with others. She uses a walker.

- **Kamala**

Kamala is confined to a wheelchair. She actively takes part in workshop activities and can sew and embroider beautifully.

- **Sunil Shantha**

Sunil Shantha is blind. He is very independent and is able to look after his daily living activities. Sunil loves to listen to music.

- **Duminda**

Duminda has Cerebral Palsy. He participates in making envelopes among other workshop activities. He enjoys music and can sing well. His parents visit him and take him home for short holidays.

- **Suresh**

Suresh is confined to a wheelchair. He is keen on envelope making. Suresh loves music and plays the drums well.

- **Ramyalatha**

Ramyalatha has Cerebral Palsy. She participates in workshop activities. Father visits her occasionally.

- **Amarawansa**

He is friendly and is keen to get involved in work related to the running of the Home. He is a very good dancer and attends a weekly workshop run by the Sunera Foundation. He has Downs Syndrome.

- **Kumari**

Kumari joined the Home in 2018. Her eyesight is weak. She enjoys taking part in activities.

STAFF

Staff is one of our greatest assets. Two of them, Chandrani and Anusha have worked for over 10 years at the Home and are well known to our regular donors.

In recent years, we have had to expand the number of paid staff to look after our aging residents. We have also found it difficult to obtain/ retain the services of a Matron and Male Attendant, partly due to the inability of paying a competitive salary.

IN MEMORIAM



Dr. Ajith Perera

(29 February 1956 – 29 October 2020)

The well-known disability Activist Dr Ajith Perera passed away in October. He served the Cheshire Home first as a Board member from 2007/08, then as an Advisor to the Board from 2012.

Dr Perera was a Chartered Chemist by profession, a former senior manager in industry and also a former test cricket umpire.

Due to a tragic accident, Dr Perera was rendered, a wheelchair bound paraplegic for the rest of his life. A large tree fell onto the vehicle he was travelling in, and instantaneously paralyzed him waist down.

Undeterred from what might have easily spelled the end for most, he then took on the cause of disability rights. His achievements in this field, are many.

Among them, being the sole petitioner and advocate in several landmark Court cases, stands out. Through the public interest fundamental rights applications – he sought, among other reliefs, redress for physically disabled persons to access all key parts of new public buildings.

May he attain the supreme bliss of Nibbana.
